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# CWSRF Basics

- Low-cost financing for a wide range of wastewater and storm water projects and other water quality protection or treatment projects
- Interest Rates from 0% to 2.375%
- Terms of up to 30 years
- Subsidy awards to qualifying public applicants when available
- Open application cycle
- Qualified borrowers include Municipalities, Counties, Water and Sanitation Districts, Mutual Domestic Water Consumer Associations, Pueblos and Tribes; Other creditworthy entities may be eligible

# NMED Brownfields Program Offers

## Targeted Brownfields Assessments (TBA)

- Free environmental assessments (Phase I, Phase II) for Brownfields sites
- A brownfield property could be an old gas station, vacant motel, former industrial site, an abandoned dump, etc... Any property with **potential or known** contamination (even asbestos, lead based paint)
- Local government units, tribal governments, quasi-public entities, and non-profits are eligible to request a TBA

## Brownfields Cleanup Revolving Loan Fund (RLF)

- Low interest loans for cleanups
- Public and private entities are eligible
- Technical assistance, outreach, cleanup oversight
